

Sanderson invests in new system

Highways engineering consultancy Sanderson Associates has invested £50,000 in a new computer system to guard against breakdown, fraud and fire.

The company, from Grange Moor, near Huddersfield, bought a system which comprises three servers and a new data storage unit. Two of the servers are located on-site along with the data storage unit, while the third physical server is located off site as a full back-up system.

The company has also introduced a new time-recording system, CoreTime from Sage, which has been incorporated into the company's own system, for schemes or development proposals Sanderson Associates is working on.
